

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

We can't stress enough that **you WILL find open holes in Rustic Knotty Walnut**, leaving spots where the back of the panel will be visible and possibly need to be filled. However, this type of rustic look is the best representation of true Rustic Knotty Walnut.

RUSTIC VENEERS

We've been offering rustic woods for quite some time now, but there's always a little subjectivity when it comes to deciding what TYPE of rustic wood is right for your project.

RANDOM QUARTERED WALNUT

Random is the least rustic of our options. It combines different, cleaner looks of quartered material and puts them together; great for a random, plank effect.

RUSTIC WALNUT

Rustic refers to the more rough look. You'll find pin knots, flares, swing grain, and unopen holes in this category of wood.

RUSTIC KNOTTY WALNUT

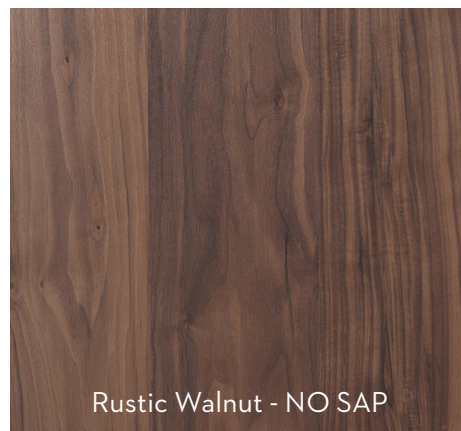
The most rustic of all is Rustic Knotty. **There WILL be open holes in this type of rustic wood.** Figured material may be included upon request.



Random Qtd Walnut - NO SAP



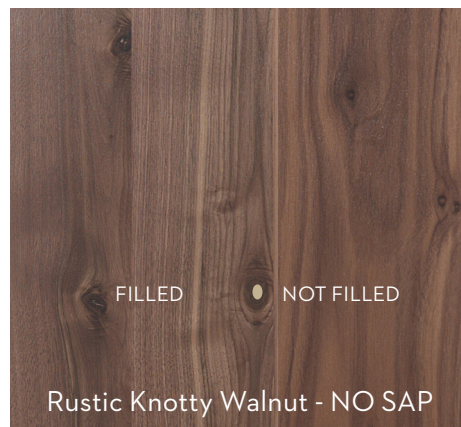
Qtd Random Walnut - SAP



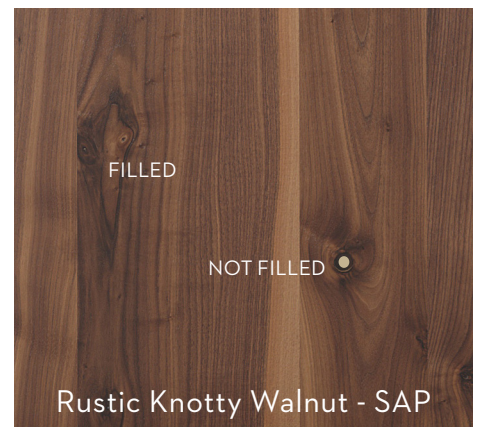

SAP vs NO SAP

Rustic Walnut has a few different variations in addition to the ones you see here. You can request Rustic Walnut with minimal sap, or amp up the rustic look by requesting that the log contain sap, which will make the lighter portion of the wood more visible and prominent.
